## MISSISSIPPI STUD ${ }^{\circledR}$ THREI-CARD BONUS SIDE BET

The three-card bonus is an optional side bet.

## GETTING STARTED

The Three Card Bonus side bet must be placed within the Three Card Bonus betting circle at
 the same time the ante bet is made. Players must have an ante bet to bet the Three Card Bonus side bet. They may not play the Three Card Bonus side bet only. Players may not make a Three Card Bonus side bet on another player's hand

## THE RULES

The dealer shall ensure that all players have placed their all wagers, and if the player wishes to, their Three Card Bonus side bet. The dealer shall ensure that all players have placed their all wagers, and if the player wishes to, their Three Card Bonus side bet.

NOTE: The 3 Card Bonus will receive action regardless of if the player folds their hand. If the player has placed a wager on the 3 Card Bonus side bet and folds, the dealer will remove the original Mississippi Stud wager(s) and tuck the folded cards under the player's 3 Card Bonus side bet.

## WINNING AND LOSING

The bet considers the three community cards. If the three community cards contain a pair or better, the bet wins.

PAYOUTS

| Hand | Pays |

| Straight Flush | 40 to 1 |
| Three of a Kind | 30 to 1 |
| Straight | 6 to 1 |
| Flush | 3 to 1 |
| Pair | 1 to 1 |

## MISSISSIPPI STUD®

Mississippi Stud ${ }^{\circledR}$ is a five-card poker game that lets you bet up to 10 units on a single hand. In Mississippi Stud ${ }^{\text {® }}$, you compete against a pay table, not against the dealer, and you win if your hand is
 a Pair of Jacks or better. The top payout is 500 to 1 for a Royal Flush and it pays on all bets!

## GETTING STARTED

Make an Ante bet to receive your first two cards. The dealer will place three community cards face down in the middle of the layout.

## PLAY OR FOLD?

At this point, you may either fold or make the 3rd Street bet of $1 x-3 x$ your Ante. The dealer then reveals the first community card. Once you see the first community card, you have a choice: fold or make the 4 th Street bet of $1 \mathrm{x}-3 \mathrm{x}$ your Ante. The dealer then reveals the second community card. Once again, you can fold or stay in the game by making the 5th Street bet from $1 \mathrm{x}-3 \mathrm{x}$ your Ante.

NOTE: When you fold, you forfeit all bets left in action.

## WINNING AND LOSING

After the dealer turns over the final community card, he resolves all wagers left in action. You win if your five-card hand is a Pair of Jacks or better (Pairs of $6 \mathrm{~s}-10 \mathrm{~s}$ push).
